## Royal Ceremonies from Coronations to Jubilees

with Chloë Cockerill MBE, MA

Chloë Cockerill was brought up near Colchester. She has an MA from Trinity College, Dublin and a Post-Graduate Diploma in Librarianship from the University of Wales. She has worked for The Churches Conservation Trust and now leads church tours as well as being a guide at Ely Cathedral. She has a special interest in heraldry, ceremonial and fabulous beasts, and belongs to the national and Cambridge University Heraldry Societies, and it was on the subject of heraldry that Chloë gave a lecture to Blackwater society in 2011.

Royal ceremonies have played an important part in the history of Great Britain from the earliest times to our present Queen's Diamond Jubilee and the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of her coronation. Today's lectures will include the history of coronations, ceremonial robes, symbols of sovereignty, orders of chivalry, the annual Garter ceremony at Windsor, the Maundy service, Trooping the Colour and reveal why St George became England's patron saint. Peers, judges, officers of state and bishops all wear ceremonial dress whose design has changed little since medieval and Tudor times. From the orb to the sceptre, the significance of the symbols of sovereignty will be examined.
