Octavia Hill's House Octavia Hill was born here in 1838. She was a founder member of the National Trust and often called Florence Nightingale of Victorian housing inspired to help create noble, happy homes for the poor in every corner of the globe.

Peckover House (NT) A Georgian Merchant's house full of surprises. Lived in by the Peckover family for 150 years. They were Quakers and operated a Bank from the premises from 1794 –1879. 2 acres of gardens, complete with orangery, summer-houses and rose garden with more than 50 varieties.
